




The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$253.82 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that will expire on June 30, 2026, and that currently costs \$256.13 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is expected to decrease the tax by \$2.32 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value.

The expiration date of the District's current levy is June 30, 2026.
